

GETTING STARTED 2 AWARDS

Awards exist to reinforce success and achievement.

The Academy have two such rewards.

The first is the CERTIFICATE of ACHIEVEMENT. It is rewarded for achievements within a course. For example, it might be presented for having passed-off a unit, or having learned a particular vocabulary, or perhaps having learned the it is upphonetic sounds of the alphabet.

In the CURRICULUM ONLY program, it is up to the parent to print and award these Certificates. Otherwise, the school awards them as a regular part of the program.

It is suggested that a binder be kept for the certificates. They could be organized chronologically, or by subject. In either case, the Certificates of Achievement are a record of your student's achievement.

The template for the Certificate of Achievement is found in the download following this one.

The second award is the CERTIFICATE of COMPLETION. This is awarded when a student has completed the Level of a subject, and when the student has completed the core classes of a subject, Scripture Study, Language Arts, Mathematics, History, and Science, in a particular Level.

These Certificates should also be organized and kept. They can be stored with the Certificates of Achievement for that subject, or mounted in a Dollar Store picture frame on the child's bedroom wall or other appropriate location.

In the CURRICULUM ONLY program, the parent awards the Certificate of Completion. Otherwise, the school awards these certificates.
