

## Overview of the Levels

- Ascent Advantage Academy Levels do NOT correspond to public school grade levels.
- Students may begin in Level 1 at any age and graduate Level 10 at any age.
- Preferred starting and graduating ages are 5 and 16.
- However, students may start as early as age 4, *if* their Learning Readiness Testing shows they are ready, *and* they are assisted by a parent.
